Working Connections

Directory of Employability Support Services in Denbighshire and Conwy 2015

RCS created 'Working Connections' Directory in order to support the Employability Toolkit that aims to raise awareness of the issues and barriers facing unemployed individuals, and of the support available to help overcome those barriers. The resource is designed to enable front-line workers across a range of organisations to provide effective signposting to employability provision for their clients and customers. The concept for the training resource was originally developed by Glasgow City Strategy in order to improve referrals by healthcare staff into employability provision.

Working Connections brings together the details of useful organisations within Denbighshire and Conwy and have identified within what areas they are able to help to try and make it easier to use. The directory provides a description of the services provided, contact details and information on eligibility criteria and referral routes, where appropriate. The directory also contains information on the stage of the 'Employability Pathway' the service most relates to. The Pathway sets out 5 stages to help people move into work, and to provide support to people whilst in work. Please note that in work support is often only available to existing clients of the service.

Stage 1 - POSITIVE ACTIVITY

Relates to a range of services helping people to get some routine into their life and make new connections

Stage 2 - WORK PREPARATION INITIAL STAGES

Relates to a range of services to help people become more self-aware, build confidence and develop their life skills.

Stage 3 - WORK PREPARATION LATER STAGES

Relates to a range of services that focus on helping people gain work related skills and prepare for moving into employment

Stage 4 - SUPPORT WITH MOVING INTO EMPLOYMENT

Relates to services that help people who are work-ready to move into employment

Stage 5 - IN WORK SUPPORT

Relates to aftercare support to help people to sustain their employment
