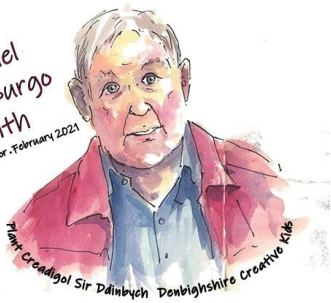

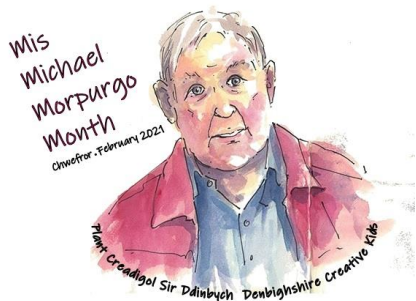
Sylw i holl awduron ifanc a selogion stori! Allech chi fod y Michael Morpurgo nesaf?

Mae Gwasanaethau Addysg a Phlant Sir Ddinbych yn lansio cystadleuaeth ysgrifennu creadigol newydd i nodi ac annog y genhedlaeth nesaf o ddarpar awduron. Ar gyfer her mis Chwefror, rydym yn ymuno â'n ffrindiau yng Ngwasanaethau Llyfrgell Sir Ddinbych i wahodd plant a phobl ifanc yn ein hysgolion i ddarllen a chymryd ysbrydoliaeth o lyfrau Michael Morpurgo, rhoi sgrifpen ar bapur a rhoi cynnig ar ein her ysgrifennu straeon byrion.

Michael Morpurgo yw un o awduron stori mwyaf poblogaidd Prydain. Mae'n aml yn darlunio pobl yn dod at ei gilydd ac yn helpu ei gilydd ar adegau o argyfwng, fel rhyfel a thrychinebau naturiol. Cred Michael Morpurgo yn angerddol yng ngallu straeon i wella, i gysuro ac ysbrydoli. Mae rhai o'i straeon mwyaf symudol wedi'u gosod yn ystod y rhyfel: War Horse (Ceffyl Rhyfel), An Eagle in the Snow, A Medal for Leroy a Private Peaceful (Caeau Fflandris), a ysbrydolwyd gan straeon bywyd go iawn, digwyddiadau a phobl.

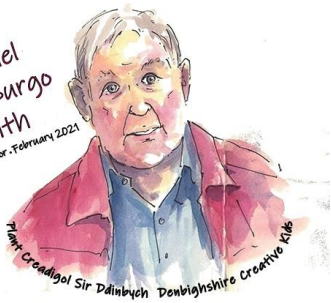

Celebrating Michael Morpurgo Month 2021

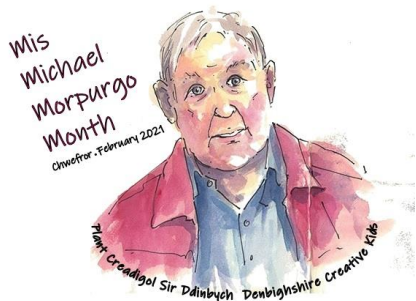
Attention budding writers and story enthusiasts! Could you be the next Michael Morpurgo?

Denbighshire Education and Children’s Services is launching a new creative writing competition to identify and encourage the next generation of budding writers. For February’s challenge, we are teaming up with our friends in Denbighshire Library Services to invite children and young people in our schools to read and take inspiration from Michael Morpurgo’s books, put pen to paper and enter our short story writing challenge.

Michael Morpurgo is one of Britain’s best-loved story makers. He has a gift for magical storytelling and his books include themes based on nature and environmental issues, community and interdependence and relationships between the old and the young. He often depicts people coming together and helping each other in times of crisis, such as war and natural disasters. Michael Morpurgo believes passionately in the power of stories to heal, to comfort and to inspire. Some of his most moving stories are set in war time: War Horse, An Eagle in the Snow, A Medal for Leroy and Private Peaceful, which were inspired by real life stories, events and people.

How to get started

- 1. Read a Michael Morpurgo book or two**
Don’t worry, you don’t have to buy them - books by Michael Morpurgo can be ordered and borrowed from your local Denbighshire library, either online or by phone. Full details can be found here:

Your ‘Michael Morpurgo-style’ Challenge

Put simply, having checked out how Michael Morpurgo starts and writes his stories, using present tense, facts, important objects or persons, characters and speech, we would like you to put pen or pencil to paper, with drawings if you like, and write a fictional short story on a theme of your choice (no longer than 500 words).

Entries will be in three age categories - **Up to 7 years, 7 to 11 years and 12 to 14 years.**

All stories can be submitted in either Welsh or English.

Some Important Dates

The competition opens on **Monday 1st February 2021** and will close at **12 noon** on **Friday 26th February 2021.**

Winners will be announced on **Thursday 4th March 2021** to mark **World Book Day.**

Prizes: Your entry will be judged by our panel of experienced creatives. The overall winning entries in each age category will be awarded a copy of one of Michael Morpurgo’s latest books, together with a unique certificate. Subject to appropriate permission/consent, all three winning short stories will be published via Denbighshire Library Services’ online platform, so that they are available to be downloaded by children, families and schools to enjoy.

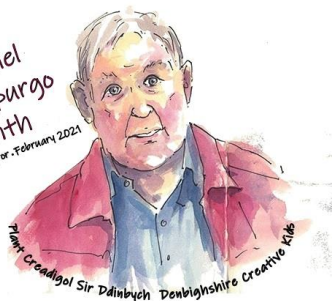

- ✎ By submitting their entry, all entrants grant Denbighshire Education and Children's Services and Denbighshire Library Services the right to publish their work on our social media platforms, website, twitter and other publicity materials.
- ✎ Judges will select the winning entries to the competition.
- ✎ The decision of judges is final.
- ✎ Denbighshire Education and Children's Services reserve the right to cancel this competition at any time should the need arise.
- ✎ The names of the winners will be published on social media channels, website, twitter, unless otherwise instructed.
- ✎ Entries will not be returned, so please keep a copy for your own records.
