## Applications are now OPEN for primary and secondary schools

Applications are now being welcomed from primary and secondary schools to take part and apply for support, as part of the Polli:Nation project, funded by the Heritage Lottery Fund.

Successful schools will be able to transform their grounds by creating bee-friendly habitats to support declining pollinator populations.

All schools in the UK will be able to apply to participate in the programme, which will be delivered by Learning through Landscapes and will enable teachers, children and volunteers to be trained to make the necessary changes to their school grounds to create habitats. They will be supported by bio-diversity and landscape experts from the charity to develop their environments by planting insect pollinator-friendly areas using pollinator-friendly plants, building bug hotels and bee houses, planting night-blooming flowers to draw in moths, constructing bee-hives, as well as promoting changes to maintenance schedules, reducing pesticides and letting areas of the school grounds become wild.
