Dear Head-teacher,

This October, Show Racism the Red Card Wales is seeking your support for **Wear Red Day 2017**.

SRtRC is an anti-racism education charity which has been working with young people and teachers since 1996.

In Wales, the charity delivers workshops to over 13,000 pupils a year, as well as providing training for teachers. Despite our efforts, young people continue to be victims of racial abuse every day in Wales. Our own consultations have found that 3/4 teachers have dealt with racism in their school without receiving proper training or support.

Following the EU referendum result in Wales, reported incidents of hate crime have risen by 28% and hate crimes against Muslim women has risen by an estimate of 300%.

We need your support

Anti-racism education has never been so important at a time of real uncertainty. You can help the charity spread its message and reach out to more and more young people in Wales.

On Friday 20th October 2017, we are encouraging everyone to fundraise for Wear Red Day. Last year, Wales raised an impressive £5,000. This money went back into the work SRtRC conducts in Wales and has enabled us to work with even more schools.

Just £50 will fund a training day for a teacher in Wales.



Ym mis Hydref, mae Dangos y Cerdyn Coch i Hiliaeth (DCCH) angen eich cefnogaeth ar gyfer **Diwrnod Gwisgo Coch 2017**.
